

Medical Mentorship Student Guidelines

Dress Code: Dress should be of a neat, conservative fashion. No denim, tennis shoes, crop or sleeveless tops, mini skirts, Capri pants, shorts, skorts or open toed shoes. An example of acceptable dress might be a polo style shirt with slacks, or business dress with skirt and blouse. Socks or nylons must be worn at all times. Please do not wear perfume, cologne, aftershave or perfumed lotions.

Medical Students on rotation will be expected to wear lab coats and/or uniforms appropriate to the area assigned.

Name Tags: Name tags must be worn by students at all times. If you do not have one, please ask the Clinic to provide one for you.

Parking: Vehicles may park in the cement parking lot adjacent to the west parking lot (with the exception of the first 15 spaces in the front row which are physician parking.)

Appearance: High standards of cleanliness and good grooming.

Professionalism: No eating or drinking in patient areas. No personal phone calls will be allowed.
